* The data in this table is for April 2014. In state fiscal year 2014, the Ohio Public Defender made one additional monthly reimbursement payment for public defender office costs. The agency made the extra payment in preparation for the implementation of the new OPD Online indigent defense information system, which will eventually replace the current paper-based system. The existing paper based system has a 60-day turnaround time for reimbursing counties for public defender costs. The new system will be designed to reimburse the counties within 30 days, and by making the extra monthly payment, the agency facilitates the transition to a 30-day payment cycle.

Under normal circumstances, in fiscal year 2014, the agency would have reimbursed the counties for public defender cases and costs from April 2013 through March 2014 (a.k.a. the "reimbursement year.") The additional payment covered cases and costs the counties experienced in April 2014.
