Contract Attorney Opportunity – Athens County, Ohio – Common Pleas

The Office of the Ohio Public Defender is seeking an experienced attorney to act as an independent contractor to provide representation to indigent clients charged with felonies in Athens County, Ohio Common Pleas Court upon appointment and/or as assigned by the Athens County Office of the Office of the Ohio Public Defender from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

The contract has a non-negotiable amount of \$1,833.00 per month or \$21,996.00 for the entire twelve-month period covered by the contract, payable in monthly installments. The contract carries a case cap of 50 felonies. These cases would be ones were the Public Defender's Office has a conflict.

To be eligible for the contract, attorneys providing representation must meet all qualifications required under section 120-1-10 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

This contract may be combined with the misdemeanor and juvenile contracts that have also been posted for Athens County, Ohio.
