


LUCAS COUNTY SYSTEM MAP, (ONE VOICE, ONE MESSAGE)

Key:

- Decision point volume is 2014 data reported on the Master Data Sheet. Data is reported for Toledo Municipal Court, Oregon Municipal Court, and Lucas County Common Pleas Court.
- African-American is displayed as A-A.
- Average time (in days) from point to point is based on 2014 data and reported separately by Toledo Municipal Court and Lucas County Common Pleas Court.


Notes:

- * The average number of days for Common Pleas Court is high since the number includes the time the case is involved with municipal court prior to indictment.
- ^ Average charge volume includes duplicate numbers. Charges for Common Pleas Court are also included in the municipal court count.
- + Municipal Court: The average was the calculation of time between bond post date/time and attorney stored on the case. In many cases, the attorney is assigned after the person posts bond. Also, the attorney may be stored as a note on the journal, but the attorney record is not stored. Decision Point 4 occurs prior to Decision Point 3.




Decision Point 1: Arrest

Decision Maker: Law Enforcement Officer/Prosecutor's Office




Decision Point 2: Charge

Decision Maker: Prosecutor/Judge




Decision Point 3: Assignment of Counsel

Decision Maker: Judge or Prosecutor




Decision Point 4: Pre Trial Release

Decision Maker: Judge/Prosecutor/Probation




Decision Point 6: Sentencing
