



U.S. State and Federal Prison Population, 1925-2013















Prison vs. The Carceral Continuum




Community is “where the action is”

Prison vs. the Carceral Continuum



Who is responsible for the management of the poor, racialized, and criminalized targets of criminal justice expansion?

- Employers
- Landlords
- Criminal Justice Actors and Agencies
- Licensing bodies and government officials
- Social Service Providers
- Families

What does this mean?

- An emergent form of citizenship, based on the *accusation* of a crime
- Heightened stakes for the everyday interactions of the criminalized, racialized and impoverished people selected for criminal justice intervention
- The “carceral citizen” as emergent social and civic category

What's to be done?

- Reimagine the carceral citizen as a protected class
- Bring the voice of justice involved people and their families into policy reform efforts
