

## Contract Attorney Opportunity – Brown County, Ohio

The Office of the Ohio Public Defender is seeking an experienced attorney to act as an independent contractor to provide representation to indigent clients in the Brown County, Ohio Common Pleas Court, Municipal Court, and Juvenile Court upon appointment and/or as assigned by the Office of the Ohio Public Defender. This contractor will replace another independent contractor. The contract will be for the remainder of fiscal year 2019, which ends June 30, 2019.

The contract has a non-negotiable amount of \$4,195.00 per month or \$50,340.00 for the original entire twelve-month period covered by the contract, payable in monthly installments. The original contract carried a case cap of 60 felonies, 112 misdemeanors or felony preliminary hearings, and 15 delinquencies in juvenile court. The contractor would be responsible for the remaining cases left under the cap and the cases currently assigned to the previous contractor.

To be eligible for the contract, attorneys providing representation must meet all qualifications required under section 120-1-10 of the Ohio Administrative Code.
